

Rules and Regulations for Park Visitors

Provincial Offences Officers and Security Staff are on patrol to protect the Conservation Area and enforce CA rules and regulations. This table lists laws commonly enforced in our Conservation Areas.

Activity	Offence	Fine
Noise and Rowdy Behaviour Please do not disturb other people or interfere with their enjoyment of the park at any time.	Make excessive noise, disturb other people	\$180
	Use abusive or insulting language	\$180
Maximum People/Vehicles per Site Too many people or vehicles can damage campsites and vegetation. 2 vehicles are permitted to be parked on a site with a max of 6 people.	Excessive number of persons occupying a campsite	\$95
	Excessive number of vehicles parked on a campsite	\$95
Alcoholic Beverages People 19 or older are permitted to possess or consume alcoholic beverages on registered campsites only.	Consume alcohol in location other than residence (campsite)	\$65
Pets Pets must always be leashed (2 m/6 ft max) and under control and not barking excessively.	Permit animal to be at large	\$95
	Permit animal to make excessive noise	\$95
Driving Posted speed in the Conservation Area is 20 km/hr.	Operate motor vehicle at excessive speed	\$125
Property Please report any damage or vandalism to Conservation Area property.	Damage, remove or deface property	\$155
Litter Please dispose of waste at garbage/recycling areas. "Stoop & Scoop" after pets.	Litter	\$155
	Fail to keep camp area clean	\$155
Campfires Fires are permitted in designated areas on campsites only. Firewood can be purchased at gatehouse; do NOT remove growth or wood (ie.deadwood) of any kind for fires.	Unlawfully start a fire	\$180
	Remove growth	\$180
Firearms & Fireworks Firearms are prohibited in the Conservation Area. Fireworks are prohibited at all times in the Conservation Area.	Unlawfully possess or discharge firearms/archery equipment	\$180
	Unlawfully ignite fireworks	\$180
Visitors Day use visitors are admitted from dawn until dusk. Campground visitors admitted from 8 am to 9 pm daily. Visitors must vacate property by 11 pm nightly.	Unlawfully remain after closing hours	\$155
